ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION (NON-PROFIT), CONTINUED:

Article 2, continued: within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to such purposes.

Article 4, continued: The Board of Directors of this religious corporation consists of one individual listed in this Article in accordance with Idaho Statute 30-30-603.

Article 8, continued: paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs, and expenses of the Corporation, for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
