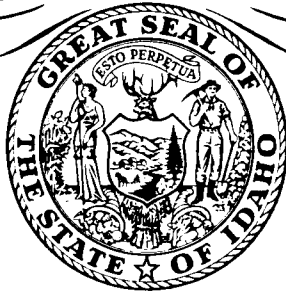

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KANIKSU TRACTOR & IMPLEMENT CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age, and all citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, and to that end we hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation shall be KANIKSU TRACTOR & IMPLEMENT CO.

ARTICLE II. The purposes of the corporation are:

(a) To engage in the business of buying, selling, leasing, repairing and servicing, and otherwise dealing in farming and logging implements, vehicles, tractors, machinery, accessories and equipment of every kind and nature.

(b) To engage in the retail business of selling merchandise of every kind and nature, including, but not limited to building and construction materials, paints, hardware, tools, pumps, and large kitchen appliances.

(c) To finance contracts, open accounts, and such other arrangements as may be necessary to sell any of the merchandise hereinabove described; and to loan money and take notes, and chattel and real mortgages thereon.

(d) To buy, sell, mortgage, pledge, invest in, trade, and deal in such real and personal properties of every kind and nature wherever located as may be for the best interests of the corporation.

(e) To do everything necessary for the accomplishment of any of the above purposes, and to do everything appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with aforesaid purposes.

ARTICLE III. The period of existence and the duration of the life of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV. The principal place of business shall be Bonner County, Idaho; the post office address of its registered office shall be Priest River, Idaho.

ARTICLE V. The stock of the corporation is divided into 5000 shares of common stock at \$100.00 par value each.

ARTICLE VI. The total authorized number of par value shares is 5000. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is \$500,000.00.
