## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THOMPSON, et al, INC.

KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being bona fide natural born citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, do, under and in pursuance of the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho, hereby organize, constitute and associate ourselves, and such other persons as may hereafter become associated with us, into a body politic and corporate, and to that end execute the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, and we hereby set forth and declare as follows:

I.

That the name of this corporation is, and shall be, THOMPSON, et al, INC.

II.

That the period of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

That the location of the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation shall be Moscow, Latah County, Idaho.

IV.

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, this corporation shall have the following objects, purposes and powers:

To purchase and sell farms and to engage in the business of farming, and of producing, merchandising, and preserving all kinds of farm and dairy products, and of planting, cultivating, growing, harvesting, cleaning and assorting, packing, boxing, shipping, buying, and selling, at wholesale and retail, all kinds of farm and

dairy products, and to carry on all other business incident thereto or connected therewith;

To engage in a general livestock and ranching business, both on its own account and as agents; to agist, feed, range, graze, manage, herd, control, brand, care for, purchase, market, and sell livestock of every kind, both on its own account and as agents for other persons or corporations; to buy, sell and deal in all classes and description of livestock; to buy, lease, cultivate, manage, operate, and sell ranch property and products therefrom both on its own account and as agents for other persons or corporations.

To purchase, own, improve, equip, operate and manage farms and engage in any agricultural pursuit or undertaking.

To conduct and carry on the business of buying, selling, and dealing in all kinds of grain, hay, or other farm produce, and farm products, livestock, and provisions.

To breed, raise, import, export, and deal in cattle, hogs, poultry and livestock of all kinds, and to carry on a general cattle and grazing business, purchasing or acquiring, and selling or otherwise disposing of the stock, supplies, equipment, accessories, appurtenances, products and by-products, of said business.

To purchase or in anywise acquire for investment or for sale or otherwise, land, contracts for the purchase of sale of lands, buildings, improvements, and any other real property of any kind or tenure or any interest therein; and as the consideration for same to pay cash or to issue the capital stock, debenture bonds, mortgage bonds, or other obligations of the corporation; and to sell, convey, lease, mortgage, hypothecate, give deeds of trust, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the corporation; and to deal generally in the development of commercial and residential real property.

To manage, improve, develop, and otherwise deal with any land or contracts for purchase or sale of lands acquired by the corpora-

tion, or in which the corporation is interested, and improving the same by laying out and preparing the same for building purposes, constructing, altering, and improving buildings thereon, and by planting, paving, draining, irrigating, cultivating, letting on building lease or building agreement, and by advancing money to, making subscriptions for, and entering into contracts and arrangements of all kinds with buildings, tenants, and others.

To purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, sell, dispose of, and otherwise deal in and turn to account, real estate; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy, and manage buildings of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this corporation, or any other person, firm or corporation.

To acquire by purchase or lease, or otherwise, lands and interests 16 in lands and to own, hold, improve, develop, and manage any real estate so acquired by the corporation, buildings or other structures with their appurtenances, and to rebuild, enlarge, alter, or improve any buildings or other structures now or hereafter erected on any land so owned, held, or occupied, and to mortgage, hypothecate, sell lease or otherwise dispose of any lands or interest in lands and in buildings or other structures, and any sores, shops, suites, rooms, or parts of any buildings or other structures at any time owned or held by the corporation.

To operate any merchandising business; buying and selling manufactured goods and producing goods for sale; to buy, lease and rent buildings for the operation of such a business; to assume all financial responsibilities in connection with such a business; and to engage in any other acts reasonably related to operating a merchandising business.

To engage in the general logging and lumber business, including, but without limitation, the manufacture and sale of lumber and lum-

ber products of all kinds; to engage in timber management, harvesting of timber, reforestation and any other act or thing incidental or related to timber and logging.

To acquire, hold, own, use, lease, let, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, sell or otherwise dispose of real or personal property what-soever that may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect any one or more of the objects of this corporation.

To make and enter into all necessary contracts and agreements, to borrow money, to lend money, to evidence the indebtedness of the corporation by notes, bonds, or other instruments and to secure the same by pledge, mortgage, trust deed or other instruments and to do all acts, and to make, execute and deliver all necessary instruments for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation; to acquire and own the stock, bonds and securities of other corporations while owning the same to exercise all the privileges of ownership consistent with the corporate character of this corporation.

To act either as, or by and through principals, agents, attorneys, trustees, contractors, factors, lessors, lessees or otherwise, either alone or in connection with others; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise all powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, without in any particular limiting any of the powers or purposes of the corporation, and in connection with its objects to do any and all things and to exercise any and all powers not prohibited by law.

V.

That the total authorized amount of the capital stock of this corporation is Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), which shall be divided into Five Thousand (5,000) shares of common stock, the par value of each share shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and such stock shall be non-assessable.
