

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

88 MAY 9 ~~1988~~ ¹⁹⁸⁸ That we, the undersigned, the President and Secretary respectively of WASHINGTON COUNTY SENIOR CITIZENS, INC., an Idaho Corporation, do hereby certify as follows:

That WASHINGTON COUNTY SENIOR CITIZENS, INC. is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the State of Idaho;

That at a special meeting held in WEISER, ID on May 6, 1988, in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-146, 30-147 and 30-148, Idaho Code, that the following is a resolution which was regularly proposed, voted upon, and adopted by two-thirds vote of all Board of Directors present, amending the Articles of Incorporation correct copy of the resolution of said membership amending the Articles of Incorporation, towit:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that Articles of Incorporation of WASHINGTON COUNTY SENIOR CITIZENS, INC. be and they hereby are amended as follows:

ARTICLE II

I. This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IX

The association is not organized for profit but is operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare and the net earnings are devoted exclusively to charitable, educational and recreational purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE X

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

That said resolution of the membership was approved on the
SIXTH day of MAY, 1988 by a majority vote of the
members present of this Corporation.
