

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of the  
BLUE WING MINING COMPANY LIMITED.  
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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:—That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation and hereby do become a corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be the Blue Wing Mining Company, Limited.

Article II.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are to work, operate, buy, sell, lease, locate, acquire, procure, hold and deal in mines, ~~minerals~~ metal and mineral claims of every kind and description, within the United States of America, to carry on and conduct general mining, smelting, milling and reduction business; to purchase, acquire, hold, erect and operate concentrating mills, electric light and power plants for the purpose of mining and treating ores and for the purpose of furnishing lights and creating power for all purposes; to buy, hold, lease, locate and hold ditches, flumes and water rights, to construct, lease, buy, sell, build, operate railroads, ferries, tramways or other means of transportation, for transporting ore, mining and other machinery and materials; to own, bond, buy, sell and lease and locate timber and timber claims, and finally to do everything consistent, proper and requisite for the carrying out of the objects and purposes aforesaid, in their fullest and broadest sense, within the territory aforesaid.

Article III.

The place where the principal business of said corporation shall be carried on shall be at Wallace, State of Idaho.

Article IV.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years, from and after the date of its incorporation.

Article V.

The number of its Directors or Trustees, who shall manage the affairs of the corporation, shall be five, and the names and residences of those who are appointed as trustees or directors to manage the same until the fourteenth day of June, 1903 are:

The capital stock of this corporation shall be one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) divided into one million shares of the par value of ten (10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) cents, each.
