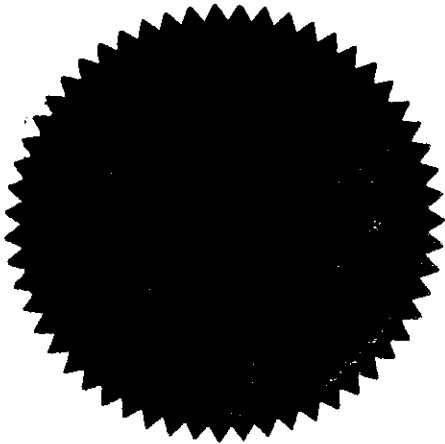

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

H & R BLOCK, INC.

We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and subscribers to the shares of the corporation to be organized pursuant hereto, for the purpose of forming a corporation under Title 12 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is: H & R BLOCK, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

(1) To perform tax services, including the preparation of tax returns; to render bookkeeping services, including the preparation of books of account, balance sheets, and profit and loss statements; and to perform any and all other services directly or indirectly related thereto; and

(2) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, establish, operate, sell and otherwise deal in, franchises of firms and persons engaged in the business of rendering tax services and preparing tax returns.

ARTICLE THREE

The term for which it is to exist is 99 years.

ARTICLE FOUR

The location and post office address of its registered office in the State of Louisiana is: 2828 Plank Road, Baton Rouge 5, Louisiana.

ARTICLE FIVE

The full name and post office address of each of its registered agents is: (1) Lewis L. Gilliland, 185 Gloria Drive, Route 1, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and (2) Shirley A. Gilliland, 185 Gloria Drive, Route 1, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

ARTICLE SIX

The total authorized number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue shall be Two Hundred (200), all of which shall be common stock having a par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share, amounting in the aggregate to \$20,000.00.

There are no preferences, qualifications, limitations, restrictions, or special or relative rights with respect to these shares.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The amount of paid-in capital with which the corporation will begin business shall be One Thousand (\$1,000,00) Dollars in lawful money of the United States.

ARTICLE EIGHT

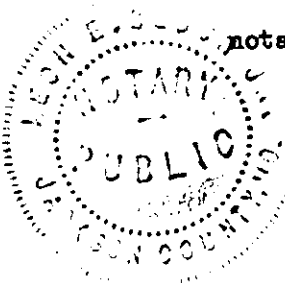
