6 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

7 That we the undersigned, residents of the State of
8 Idaho and citizens of the United States of America, of full
9 age of majority, have for the purpose of forming a non-
10 profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho
11 Code, for the purposes expressed in ARTICLE II hereof,
12 adopted the following Articles of Incorporation:
13

14 ARTICLE I

15 The name of this corporation shall be TRINITY FELLOWSHIP,
16 A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION.
17

18 ARTICLE II

19 This corporation is organized for the non-profit purpose
20 of establishing and maintaining a place for the worship of the
21 Almighty God, our Heavenly Father; to provide for Christian
22 fellowship for those of like faith, where the Holy Ghost may
23 be honored; to assume our share of the responsibility and the
24 privilege of propagating the Gospel of Jesus Christ by all
25 available means, both at home and in foreign lands.

26 The powers and authority of this corporation shall be
27 as follows:

- 28 (a) To operate under the name set forth in ARTICLE I
29 above;
- 30 (b) To employ qualified legal counsel and other necessary
31 personnel to carry out the purposes of this corporation;
- 32 (c) To accept financial aid from the United States of

1 America and any other source in order to carry out the
2 purposes hereof;

3 (d) To conduct its activities in accordance with and
4 subject to all applicable State and Federal laws and regu-
5 lations;

6 (e) To make reports to its members as may be required
7 in the By-laws;

8 (f) To adopt and use a corporate seal;

9 (g) To make contracts;

10 (h) By its Board of Directors to appoint such officers
11 and employees as may be decreed proper; define their authority
12 and duties; fix their compensation; require bonds of such of
13 them as it deems advisable and fix the penalty thereof;
14 dismiss such officers or employees, or any thereof for any
15 good reason and appoint others to fill their places;

16 (i) To adopt By-laws regulating the manner in which
17 its officers and employees shall be appointed, its property
18 transferred and the privileges granted to it by law exercised
19 and enjoyed;

20 (j) To acquire, hold, operate, mortgage, hypothecate,
21 and dispose of any property (real, personal or mixed) whenever
22 necessary or appropriate to the carrying out of its lawful
23 functions; and

24 (k) To exercise such incidental powers as may reasonably
25 be necessary to carry out the business for which the corpora-
26 tion is established, provided that such incidental powers
27 shall be exercised in a manner consistent with tax-exempt
28 status under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the
29 United States.

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ARTICLE III

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The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

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ARTICLE IV

The name of the registered agent and the location and post office address of the corporation's registered office in the State of Idaho is HENRY AGUILERA, 2282 Ridgeview Way, Boise, Idaho, 83706, respectively.

ARTICLE V

The number of directors of this corporation shall not be less than the number required by the laws of the State of Idaho, the exact number and qualifications of which shall be established in the By-laws. The Board of Directors shall conduct all of the business of the corporation except that business specifically delegated to its Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VI

This non-profit corporation is formed without any purpose of pecuniary profit to itself or its members and shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VII

(a) Membership in the corporation shall be accorded to any person fifteen (15) years of age or older who is interested in the purposes of the corporation.

(b) The private property of members of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts and no member shall become individually liable or responsible for any debts or liabilities of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

Upon dissolution of the corporation for any cause, all of the assets and property, both real and personal, then owned or controlled by this corporation shall revert to and

1 become the property of an eleemosynary institution accorded
2 tax-exempt status under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
3 Code of the United States to be designated by the Board of
4 Directors; provided, however, that the just debts and liabil-
5 ities of the corporation shall first be paid. Upon dissol-
6 ution, none of the assets or property of the corporation
7 shall devolve to the benefit of any officer, director,
8 employee or member of this corporation.

9

10 ARTICLE IX

11 These Articles may be amended at any regular meeting of
12 the membership of the corporation, or at a special meeting
13 called for that purpose, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of
14 the members present.

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16 ARTICLE X

17 The undersigned incorporators shall act as the initial
18 Board of Directors until their successors shall have been
19 duly qualified and elected.


