Articles of Incorporation

Article I

Name and Objective

- Section 1 The name of the Corporation shall be Idaho Search and Rescue Dogs, Incorporated, hereafter referred to as ISARD.
- Section 2 The Objectives of the Corporation shall be:
 - A. To train handler/dog teams for the purposes of search and rescue, to lend aid to law enforcement agencies and to educate the public in search and safety.
 - B. To meet ISARD standards as set forth by corporation members in order to become a field ready search and rescue team.
- Section 3 The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be Section 4 distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the puposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Section 5 The members of the Corporation shall adopt and may from time to time revise such by-laws.

Article II

Location of Corporation

Section 1 The initial registered offices of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be 1220 N 1150 East
Shelley, ID 83274 and Ann L. Christensen is the initial registered agent at that office.

Article III

Initial Directors

ISARD shall have no less than three (3) directors. One of the directors is Ann L. Christensen whose place of residence is located at 1220 N 1150 E, Shelley, ID 83274,

Article IV

Incorporator

Ann L. Christensen, whose mailing address is 1220 N 1150 E, Shelley, ID 83274, is the incorporator for ISARD.

Article V

Membership

Section 1 ISARD will admit members to the corporation in accordance with requirements set forth in Article I of the ISARD by-laws.

- Section 2 Members will be designated as one of the following according to the requirements set forth by Article I of the corporation by-laws:
 - 1. Operational Member
 - 2. Non-operational Member
 - 3. Associate Member

Article VI

Dissolution

This corporation may be dissolved only by a unanimous vote of the general membership of the corporation. Upon final dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal, Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
