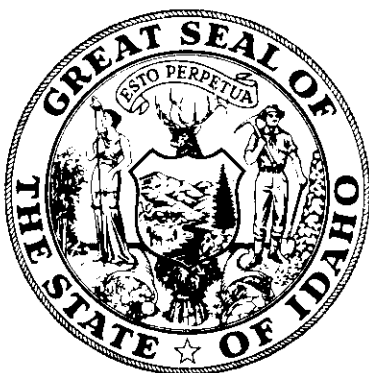
S. K. ENTERPRISES, INC.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

S. K. ENTERPRISES

We, the undersigned natural persons of lawful age, residing in the city of Boise, State of Idaho, do associate ourselves as incorporators to form a corporation and do hereby adopt the following as Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: S. K. Enterprises, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose, or purposes, for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the laws of the State of Idaho. Without limiting in any manner the scope and generality of the foregoing, it is hereby provided that the corporation shall have the following purposes, objects, and powers:

A. To own, lease, deal in, maintain, and operate an office or offices for the purpose of furnishing information and references to travels and tours, both domestically and internationally, on airlines, whether commercial or otherwise, buses, railroads, steamships, and other means of travel or transportation, and to collect information regarding the foregoing; to plan and promote tours, journeys, and travels in all parts of the world; to furnish information regarding hotels, motels, inns, and other places for the accommodation of travels in all parts of the world; to act when duly authorized as agent for the sale of tickets for transportation on airlines, buses, railroads, steamships, and other means of transportation; to collect and furnish information of all sorts in connection with journeys in and to all parts of the world.

B. To print, publish, and issue from time to time travel booklets, pamphlets, schedules, and other publications or literature, promoting travel through the offices of the corporation.

C. To borrow or raise monies for any of the purposes of the corporation, and, from time to time, without limit as to amount, to draw, make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures, and other negotiable or non-negotiable instruments and evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the payment of any thereof and of the interest thereon by mortgage upon or pledge, conveyance, or assignment in trust of the whole or any part of the property of the corporation, whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired, and to sell, pledge, or otherwise dispose of such bonds or other obligations of the corporation for its corporate purposes.

D. To purchase, receive, take by grant, give, devise, bequest, or otherwise, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, employ, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated, and to sell, convey, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, or mortgage or pledge, all or any of the corporation's property and assets, or any interest therein, wherever situated.

E. To apply for, obtain, register, purchase, lease, acquire, secure, own, hold, use, operate, contract or negotiate for, take licenses or other rights in respect of, sell, transfer, grant licenses and rights in respect of, manufacture under, introduce, sell, assign, collect the royalties on, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise create liens upon, or dispose of, deal in, and turn to account, letters patent, patents, patent rights, patents applied for or to be applied for, trademarks, trade names and symbols, distinction marks and identifications of origin or ownership, copyrights, syndicate rights, inventions, discoveries, devices, machines, improvements, processes, data, formulae of any and all kinds granted by or recognized under or pursuant to the laws of the United States of America, or any other country or countries whatsoever.

F. To purchase, own, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, create liens upon, or otherwise dispose of, insofar as may be done under the laws of the State of Idaho, any of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, debentures, notes, securities or other evidences of indebtedness, created, issued, or incurred by, any public, municipal or quasipublic, public service, or private corporations or associations, wherever organized or created, and as owner thereof to exercise all rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote upon any stock thus owned; and to aid in any manner which shall be lawful any corporation or association of which any bonds, stocks, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness shall be held by this corporation, and to do any acts and things permitted by law and design to protect, preserve, improve or enhance the value of any such bonds, stocks, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness.

G. To have one or more offices and to carry on any and all of its businesses and operation without restriction or limit as to amount, either within or without the State of Idaho, any other states, the District of Columbia, the territories, colonies, and dependencies of the United States of America, and in all or any foreign countries or in any part of the world.

The foregoing shall be construed both as objectives and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and the corporation shall have, possess, and exercise any and all other powers, express or implied, as may be incidental to the conduct and transaction of its business and affairs, or necessary or expedient for the attainment of its corporate purposes, and such other powers as may now or hereafter be conferred upon the corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV

The aggregate number of shares which this corporation shall have authority to allot, the classes of such shares, and the par value thereof are as follows:

ARTICLE V

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, but not by less than two (2) such directors.

ARTICLE VI

The address of its registered office in the State of Idaho is: 216 West State, Boise, Idaho 83702.

The name of its registered agent at such address is: Suzanne G. Overstreet.

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors to be elected at the first meeting of shareholders is three (3), and the names and address of the individuals who shall serve as the initial Board of Directors until their successors shall be elected and qualified are as follows:


