### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**AUTO BUYERS SERVICE CO., INC.,**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Eighteenth** day of **April** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty** and duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Pocatello,** in the County of **Bannock.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
AUTO BUYERS SERVICE CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, residents of the State of Idaho, and all of legal age, have today voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho and hereby certify;

I.

Name of said corporation shall be AUTO BUYERS SERVICE CO., INC.

II.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho shall be 201 Pioneer Bldg., Pocatello, Idaho.

IV.

The amount of the authorized capital stock of the corporation shall be Ten Thousand and no/100ths (\$10,000.00) Dollars, divided into ten thousand shares of common stock of the par value of One and no/100ths (\$1.00) Dollars per share. All of the stock shall be of the same class, have the same powers and voting rights and shall be nonassessable for any purpose whatsoever.

V.

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors and consisting of no less than three Directors. The qualification, term of office, manner of electing directors, number of Directors to be elected, the time, place and manner of calling meetings, and the powers and duties of the Directors shall be prescribed by the By-Laws. The names and post office addresses of

the Directors until the first annual meeting of the stockholders are as follows:

## VI.

The purposes for which said corporation is organized are as follows:

(a) To aid, assist, advise and counsel persons who are seeking or who may desire to purchase new or used automobiles, their parts or accessories; to provide information, pamphlets, and data relating to the current purchase prices and availability of all types and styles of new or used automobiles, their parts or accessories; to print, publish, sell and distribute in the mail, or by subscription, or otherwise, pamphlets, papers, brochures, cards or letters relating to the purchase and availability of all types and styles of new or used automobiles, their parts or accessories.

(b) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and to hold, own, sell or dispose of real and personal property of all kinds, including stocks and securities of other corporations.

(c) To borrow money for its corporate purposes and to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures or other obligations from time to time for the purchase of property for any purpose in or about the business of the corporation, and if deemed proper to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise.

(d) To acquire and take over as a going concern and thereafter to carry on any person, firm or corporation engaged in any business which this corporation is authorized to conduct and in connection therewith to acquire the good will and all or any of the assets and to conduct or otherwise provide for all or any of such businesses.

(e) To sell and hold, manage, develop, lease, mortgage, dis-

pose of, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the corporation.

(f) To carry on business at any place or places within the jurisdiction of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, and to purchase, hold, mortgage, convey, lease or otherwise deal with any real or personal property had in such place or places.

(g) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary and convenient for the business of the corporation with any person, firm, corporation, association, body politic, state or other form of government so far as and to the same extent that the same may be done and performed by corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho.

(h) To do all and everything necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects, or in furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in connection with other corporations, firms, or individuals, either as principal or as agent, and to do every other act or acts, things or thing, incidental to or appertaining to, or growing out of, or connected with the aforesaid objects, purposes or powers or any of them.

(i) To have the power and to do those acts, things and deeds set forth in Section 30-114 of the Idaho Code and any and all amendments thereto.

#### VII.

The power to repeal and amend the By-Laws and adopt new By-Laws of this corporation is hereby conveyed to the Directors, which power is to be exercised by a majority vote of said Directors.
