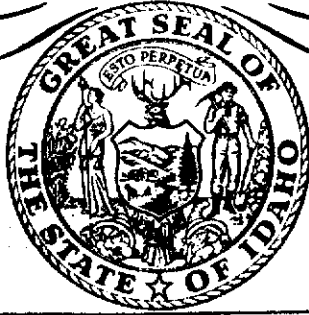

The auditor and recorder is also hereby required to furnish to the various judges and clerks of said election poll lists and tally sheets, together with the blank ballots and all necessary supplies provided by the general laws of the State for the conduct of said election.

This being also the quarterly meeting, the following business was presented and considered:

A committee representing a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed Village of Declo, presented a petition asking that they be allowed to incorporate as a village. A verbal protest was presented but without showing why such petition should be allowed. Wherefore, the Board approved said petition and granted the petitioners permission to proceed to incorporate as a village.

The following persons were appointed as a Board of Trustees for said Village to hold office until the fourth Tuesday in April, 1921:

Sam Gillette, W. C. Harroun, H. Thomas, C. A. Cleveland
A. K. Friesen.

Deputy Sheriff, J. C. McGarry, submitted his statement for the months of November and December and the same was approved.

Deputy Sheriff, R. H. Smith, also presented his statement for the months of November and December, which was also approved.

Sheriff W. O. Pratt, submitted two statements, one from July 11, 1919 to October 3, 1919 and the other from October 6, 1919 to January 5, 1920, and the same were approved.

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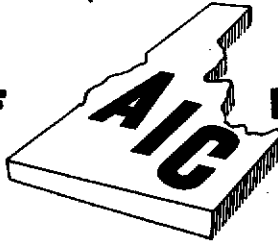

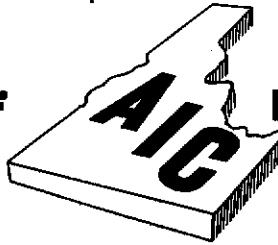

- WHEREAS: H. B. 3 was passed by the 39th session of the Idaho Legislature and duly signed by the Governor, and,
 - WHEREAS: H. B. 3 changed the status of corporate villages to corporate cities, and,
 - WHEREAS: H. B. 3 provides that all cities shall be governed by a Mayor and Council, and,
 - WHEREAS: H. B. 3, among other provisions, establishes the powers and responsibilities of the Mayor and Council, and,
 - WHEREAS: H. B. 3 is in full force and effect;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Deeds does hereby resolve to adopt such ordinances as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of H. B. 3.
