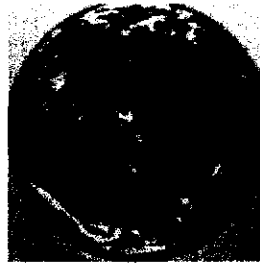

- 2) Lobby with our local and national politicians to create more sustainable development, transportation and laws

FUNDING AND OPERATIONS:

Funding for BUILD A BETTER PLANET will come from various sources as noted below.

- 1) Partnerships with general contractors, suppliers, architects and corporate sponsors for project development, donating a percentage of profits and or materials to the nonprofit organization.
- 2) Federal Grants and Charitable Donations from Foundations.

Article 8:

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
