# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE

ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO ELECTROLOGISTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we the undersigned citizens of the United States of America of full age, and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves togeather for the purpose of forming a corporation under title 30 Chapter 10 of the Idaho Code, intitled "Non-profit Cooperative Associations" AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY.....

### ARTICLE 1

The name of this corporation shall be: The Association of Idaho Electrologists,

ARTICLE II

THE OBJECTIVES OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE:

- 1. to foster high standards of electrology practice, promote the professional and educational advancement of electrolysis within our profession, and the general public. These purposes shall be unrestricted by considerations of nationality, race, creed, color, or sex.
- 2, to establish functions, standards, and qualifications for electrolysis practice.
- 3. to enunciate standards of electrolysis education and implement them through appropriate channels, as deemed by this association, and/or any State laws, and/or licensesure that may or may not follow in time to come.
- 4. to establish a code of ethical conduct for all practioneoners, practicing within this corporation.
- 5. to stimulate and promote research designed to enlarge the knowledge on which this practice is based.
- 6. to provide for the continuing professional development of practioners to be the representative association for practicing electrologists in the State of Idaho.
- 7. and to serve as a voice in and with the allied regional and national organizations and assiciations, and the general public.

ARTICLE III

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV
