

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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RATCHO OIL CO.

We, the undersigned, Pat Griffin, H. M. Savage and Evelyn P. Wiggen, citizens of the United States of America, and residents of the County of Lar mer and State of Colorado, each of the age of more than twenty-one years, have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the general corporation Laws of the State of Colorado, in accordance with the provisions of said Laws, and do hereby execute and acknowledge in duplicate these certificates in writing, which when filed shall constitute the Articles of Incorporation of Rancho Oil Co., as follows:

Τ.

The name of the Corporation shall be:

RANCHO OLL CO.

II.

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual;

III.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) To wholesale petroleum and allied products;
- (b) To purchase, acquire and operate all equipment incident to the foregoing purpose;

IV.

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to issue is, 49,990 shares of the par value of \$1.00 per share. All such stock shall be common stock with identical rights and privileges and shall be fully paid and non-assessable.

Cumulative voting shall not be permitted in the election of directors.

VI.

Each shareholder shall have the preemptive right to acquire additional or treasury shares of the Corporation.

VII.

The principal place of business of the Company shall be at 701 North College Avenue, in the City of Fort Collins, County of Larimer, and State of Colorado.

Avenue in Fort Collins, Colorado, and its initial registered agent shall be Pat Griffin, at said address. Meetings of the Board of Directors and of the stockholders of the Company may be held outside the State of Colorado at such time and place in each instance as may be designated in the by-laws or by resolution of the Board of Directors.

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors and the names and addresses of the incorporators and of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until their successors be elected and qualified, are:
