ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of full age and all citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under Title 30, Chapter 1102, of the Idaho Code, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

That the name of the corporation shall be SALMON COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC.

ARTICLE II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To preach and spread the gospel and to encourage people to have more interest in religion and christianity and to adhere to the Golden Rule.

This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

ARTICLE III

The duration of this corporation is to be FIFTY YEARS.

ARTICLE IV

That the principal office for the transaction of business of this corporation shall be at Salmon, County of Lemhi, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The undersigned incorporators hereby set forth that an election has been held for directors of this corporation and that said election was held in accordance with Section 30-1102 of the Idaho Code and that said election was held on July 31, 1964, at eight o'clock p.m. at the church property at the corner of Main Street and North Third Street in Salmon, Idaho, and that a majority of the members of this organization who were present at such meeting voted at such election and the result was that the persons whose names appear herein below were elected such directors and that these facts were verified by the presiding officer and that before

holding said election, notice of the time and place of holding such election was given by publication at least two weeks in the Recorder Herald which is the official newspaper of Lemhi County, State of Idaho, and is located at Salmon, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VIII

That the by-laws of this corporation shall be adopted by the directors named in the Articles of Incorporation and may thereafter be amended or repealed by any means provided in the by-laws.
