ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF BOISE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Chapter 10 of "The Business Corporation Act" of the State of Idaho, and certify as follows:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be: JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF BOISE, INC.

Article II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) Specifically and primarily to educate boys and girls in the basic concepts of Americanism, and as one of said basic concepts, in a knowledge of and respect for what is universally known and recognized as the American private enterprise system; and in connection therewith, to provide opportunities for boys and girls to organize themselves into small enterprises, to be wholly operated by them, under the guidance of advisors furnished by business firms participating in the program, and thus to acquire a knowledge of the problems and fundamentals of business.

(b) To receive property by devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by will, and otherwise acquire and hold all property, real or personal.

(c) To convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, encumber, transfer upon trust, or otherwise dispose of all property, real and personal.

(d) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation, and to receive, hold, administer, and expend funds and property subject to such trust.

(e) To borrow money, contract debts, execute notes, and secure the payment or performance of its obligations.

(f) To make contracts; and to do all other acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of the corporation.

Article III.

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Article IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Boise, in the County of Ada, State of Idaho.

Article V.

This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for non-profit purposes and no part of any net earnings thereof shall inure to the benefit of any member or other individual.

Article VI.

The corporation formed hereby shall have no capital stock, and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders. The corporation shall not collect dues or levy assessments, but may receive voluntary contributions.

Article VII.

The voting power and property rights and interests of the members shall be equal, and the conditions and regulations of membership shall be determined and fixed by the bylaws.
