

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

IDAHO FALLS SYMPHONY SOCIETY, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Tenth** day of **October,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls** in the County of **Bonneville** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
IDAHO FALLS SYMPHONY SOCIETY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full legal age and citizens of the United States, and residents of the State of Idaho, for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, relating to private corporations, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together, and hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this association shall be and is Idaho Falls Symphony Society, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless the same is sooner dissolved or disincorporated pursuant to law.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation is organized at, and the place of its principal office and place of business shall be Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The association shall not engage in any business, trade, avocation or profession for gain or profit.

ARTICLE V.

This association shall not issue any capital stock, but it shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates shall not be assignable so the transferee can, by such transfer alone, become a member of the association. Each such transferee shall become a member of the association only by resolution of the Board of Directors, and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal.

ARTICLE VI.

That the names and post office addresses of the incorporators, each of whom is to be a member of the association, are as follows:

ARTICLE VII.

The purposes and objects of this association are, and shall be, to cultivate, promote, foster, sponsor and develop the understanding, taste and love of the musical arts, and to lawfully do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the attainment of any of the purposes, the accomplishment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinabove set forth, and to have, enjoy, and exercise any and all rights, powers, privileges, and exemptions which are now or which may hereafter be conferred upon corporations organized pursuant to the non-profit corporations laws of the State of Idaho as they now exist or may be amended or supplemented.

ARTICLE VIII.

The association shall have the right and authority to enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind, essential, necessary or proper in the transaction of its ordinary affairs, or for the welfare of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

The private property of members of this association shall not be liable for the debts of the association.

ARTICLE X.

The power to repeal and amend the by-laws and adopt new by-laws is hereby conferred upon the Board of Directors.
