ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

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SEC. OF STATE

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The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I.

NAME

The name of this corporation is High Country Tractor Co.

ARTICLE II.

DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in the transaction of any or all lawful purposes for which the corporation may be incorporated under the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

AUTHORIZED SHARES

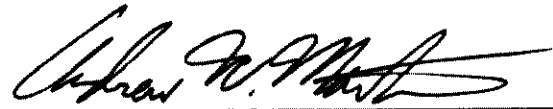
ARTICLE IX.
