ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF CALDWELL,
IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned,
all of whom are ^{citizens}~~residents~~ of the State of Idaho, do hereby
voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of
forming and incorporating a religious organization under and
by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 11 of Title 29, Idaho
Code Annotated, 1932, and hereby make, subscribe and execute
the following articles of incorporation, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation is and shall be "THE FIRST
PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF CALDWELL, IDAHO, INCORPORATION."

ARTICLE II

Purpose and Powers

This corporation is a non-profit organization and is
formed for religious, charitable and benevolent purposes and
especially the following:

1. To provide facilities for religious education, worship,
fellowship and recreation.
2. To foster and encourage the spirit of Christianity
according to the doctrines and teachings of the Presbyterian
Church of the United States of America.
3. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own
and exercise all rights of ownership in, and to sell, transfer,
or mortgage, real and personal property, to erect buildings

or other structures necessary or proper for the carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned.

4. To enter into all contracts necessary or proper in conducting its affairs and to render such benevolent aid and comfort to its members as may be provided by its By-Laws; also to receive donations and to receive, manage, take and hold real and personal property by gift, grant, devise or bequest.

ARTICLE III

Place of Business

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Caldwell, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

Term of Existence

The term of existence of this corporation is and shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

Capital Stock

This corporation does not have, and shall not have, any capital stock, neither shall it issue to its members, certificates representing capital stock, and this corporation shall not be operated for a pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE VI

Directors

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than six, which number may be increased at any time in conformity with the By-Laws. The term of office of each director and the manner of election shall be provided for in the By-Laws, and the Board of Directors shall be known as,

and shall conduct the affairs of this corporation, under the designation and style of "Board of Trustees". The names and addresses of those who are to serve as incorporating directors and until the election and qualification of their successors are as follows:

ARTICLE VII

Membership

The qualifications for membership in this corporation and the method of election to membership shall be provided for in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII

By-Laws

The By-Laws of this Corporation may be repealed and amended, and new By-Laws adopted, by the Board of Trustees; provided, they shall not make or alter any By-Law fixing their qualification, classification, term of office, or compensation.

ARTICLE IX

Statement of Facts

Pursuant to a notice published in the Caldwell News-Tribune, a newspaper published in Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, on September 16th, September 23rd, and September 30th, 1939, a copy of which notice and the affidavit of publication thereof being attached to these Articles, a meeting of the members of The First Presbyterian Church of Caldwell,

Idaho, was held on Tuesday, the 3rd day of October, 1939, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M., at the Presbyterian Church on 9th and Albany Streets in Caldwell, Idaho, at which time and place a majority of the members of this corporation were present and voted at the election held at said meeting and the persons above named were duly elected as the incorporating directors of this corporation and until the election and qualification of their successors, and that R. E. PASLEY and BESS STEUNENBERG were the Chairman and Secretary, respectively of said meeting and were the officers conducting said election.

ARTICLE X

Amendments

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any respect at any regular or special meeting of members called for that purpose. An amendment must first be approved by two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees and then adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present and voting at said meeting, provided, that a quorum, as specified by the By-Laws, be present. Notice of any proposed amendment shall, after approval of two-thirds of the Board of Trustees, be given to the members in the manner provided by Section 29-1103, Idaho Code Annotated, 1932, or amendments thereof.
