Articles of Incorporation of the Seattle, Boise and Salt Lake Railway Company.

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho: And we Certify;

First, - That the name of said Corporation is the Seattle, Boise and Salt Lake Railway Company.

Second, - That the purposes for which it is formed are to Construct, operate and Maintain a single track railroad of Standard gauge, together with all necessary side tracks and switches, depots, water tanks, Station houses and buildings of every kind that may be needed; to acquire by purchase or lease, or both, so as to own, have and possess all necessary grounds for right of way, depot grounds, also grounds for the location of repair shops, and for all other necessary purposes; to own or lease, or both, all necessary rolling stock and Locomotive power; to employ all necessary help and assistance of every kind; and to do, and to have all such acts and things as may become necessary to completely Construct, operate and Maintain such rail road.

Third. - That the said railroad shall extend from a point on the boundary line between the State of Idaho and the Territory of Utah, at or near where the said boundary line is crossed by the road running from Keltou in Utah, to Kelso in Idaho; Thence in a North Westerly direction to Boise City, Idaho; Thence northerly to a point on the boundary line between the States of Washington and Idaho, at or near the Town of Lewiston in Idaho; together with a divergence westerly of about twenty miles at about latitude of forty five (45) degrees north, and also from same point of divergence, a divergence easterly to Great Payette Lake, a distance of about twenty five miles; altogether being a distance of about five hundred and twenty five (525) miles in the State of Idaho,

Fourth. - That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the City of Boise. County of Ada, and the State of Idaho.

Fifth. - That the term for which it is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Sixth. - That the number of its Directors shall be seven (7); and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are;

Seventh.- That the amount of the Capital Stock of this Corporation shall be Twenty Million (20,000,000) dollars, divided into Two Hundred Thousand (200,000) Shares of the par value of One Hundred (100) dollars each.

Eighth.- That the amount of said Capital Stock which has been actually subscribed is one million and Eighty Seven Thousand (1,087,000) dollars; and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to wit;

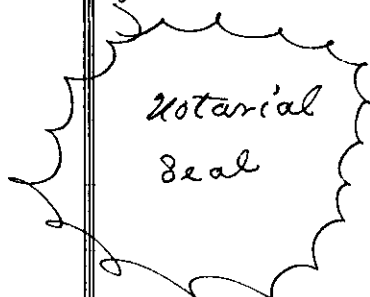
