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The undersigned incorporators, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following articles ofincorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is AMERICAN TOTAL TO RESOURCE MANAGEMENT, INC.

Purposes. acquire, develop and sell real property and engage in general forestry, timber and resource management. The corporation may further engage in any or all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR
