#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

GALLUP YARDS, INC.

We, the undersigned, being residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, hereby mutually agree to unite and associate ourselves as a corporation, and for such purpose we hereby make, execute and adopt the following articles of incorporation.

### Article One

The name of this corporation shall be the GALLUP YARDS, INC.

## Article Two

The objects and purposes of this corporation shall be:

1. To conduct a yard or yards, store or stores, for the purchase and sale at retail and wholesale of lumber, fuel,

lumber products, building materials, hardware, and all other articles of merchandise necessary or convenient in connection therewith.

- 2. To manufacture, buy, sell and deal in building materials of all kinds and classes and everything in connection therewith.
- 5. To manufacture, buy, sell and deal in forest produets of all kinds.
- 4. To erect, maintain, purchase, or rent, hire, lease, let or otherwise acquire or dispose of buildings, manufacturing plants or structures for such purposes. To acquire, sell, mortgage, lease or otherwise acquire or dispose of all real or personal property necessary or convenient to such business.
- 5. To hire and contract all necessary labor in connection with or convenient to such business.
- 6. To build houses, dwellings, buildings or structures for rent, sale or other purposes, and to acquire necessary lands and lots therefor, and to make all business arrangements necessary or convenient thereto.
- 7. To purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of the stock, bonds, and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, and the obligations of private persons and business combinations, for the purposes of said business.
- 8. And to generally do all those acts convenient or necessary to the business of this corporation, or conducive, or helpful therete, directly or indirectly.

### Article Three

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be at Moscow, in the County of Latah, State of Idaho.

#### Apticle Four

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be Fifty (50) Years from and after the date of incorporation.

### Article Five

tion shall be managed and controlled by a board of directors, consisting of not less than three nor more than seven of the stockholders of this corporation, the number to be decided, and the selection thereof to be made at the annual meeting of the corporation, each year, for the year then beginning. The number of directors for the first year and until the first annual meeting of this corporation shall be three, unless the board of directors shall appoint additional directors to hold office during such first year and until the first annual meeting of the corporation.

#### Article Six

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Twenty-five Thousand Bollars (\$25,000.00), all of the same being common stock. Of the common stock there shall be two hundred fifty (250) shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation which has already been subscribed is forty (40) shares, and the persons by whom subscribed, and the number of shares subscribed by each, are as follows, and each of the said persons agrees to take and pay for the amount of stock set after his name:
