That we, the undersigned, being natural citizens of the United States and of full age and majority, have this day and do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II.

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are:

To generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise,
 act or vocation permitted or authorized pursuant to the provisions
 of Idaho Business Corporation Act and Amendments thereto.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existance.

ARTICLE IV.

The total number of shares of which the corporation is authorized to issue is one thousand (1,000). The aggregate par value of such shares is One Hundred Thousand Dollars, each share is One hundred dollars (\$100.00).
