We, WALTER J. BRUNGER and W. D. VINCENT,

State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

That at a meeting expressly called for the purpose of considering the matters hereinafter set forth, held on Monday, the 10th day of March, 1947, at 1:00 p.m., at the Young Men's Christian Association Building, 11th and Idaho Streets, Boise, Idaho, at which said meeting a quorum was present, the two following resolutions were discussed and adopted by unanimous vote of all members present at said meeting:

1. BE IT RESOLVED, That Article 4 of the Articles of incorporation of the Young wen's Christian Association of Boise City, Idaho, be amended to read as follows:

"Fourth: That the term for which this corporation is to exist shall be perpetual and same is hereby made perpetual."

2. BE IT RESOLVED, That Article 5 of the said Articles of Incorporation be amended to read as follows:

"FIFTH: That the number of its directors shall be twenty-four."
