

Articles of Incorporation of the Portneuf Irrigating Company.

Know All Men by these Presents:
That we the undersigned have this day voluntarily
associated ourselves together for the purpose of
forming a Corporation under the laws of Idaho
Territory.

And we hereby certify:

First. That the name of said Corporation be
The Portneuf Irrigating Company.

Second. - That the purposes for which it is
formed are the appropriation and diversion of the
waters of the Portneuf River in the County of Bingham
Territory of Idaho. To be used for agricultural and
domestic purposes and for all purposes incidental
to and necessary in the proper enjoyment
of the uses of said water for agricultural and
domestic purposes.

Third. That the place where its principal
business is to be transacted shall be the town
of Oneida Bingham County, Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist
is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its
Incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of its Directors shall
be five (5) and that the names and residences
of those who are appointed for the first year or
until the first election of said officers under
the by laws of this Corporation are:
