#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - NONPROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, residents of the State of Idaho, being of legal age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

### ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the corporation is "AUSTIN ACADEMY, INC."

### ARTICLE TWO ADDRESS

The post office address of the corporation's principle office is 13 S. Austin Surgar City, Idaho 83448. The name of it's initial registered agent at such address is Rodney Earl Larsen.

## ARTICLE THREE TYPE OF CORPORATION

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

### ARTICLE FOUR DURATION

The period of duration of this nonprofit corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE FIVE CORPORATE PURPOSE

This nonprofit corporation is organized for the following purposes: to establish and operate a school for persons ages three through seventeen covering the levels of kindergarten, lower elementary and through high school. To establish, maintain, and operate recreational and educational institutions. To own, maintain, and operate land, facilities, and equipment for use in connection with such institutions for the purpose of enjoyment and learning whether theoretical or practical. To diseminate knowledge in all areas whether academic, physical or vocational. The corporation shall have the right to do and accomplish all things and engage in any other lawful transactions which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Laws of Idaho might do, accomplish, or engage in.

### NO PECUNIARY GAIN

This corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. It shall not have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its new earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual. The corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Five above.

### ARTICLE SEVEN CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

The conditions and regulations of membership and the rights and other privileges of the classes of membership shall be determined and fixed by the ByLaws of this corporation.

## ARTICLE EIGHT LIMITATION OF MEMBER'S LIABILITY

The private property of the members of this corporation shall not be liable for its corporate debts.
