ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LEADORE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being of legal age and being citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby, as incorporators thereof, for a non-profit co-operative association under the laws of the State of Idaho, according to and in compliance with Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and Section 30-117A, and we do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I.

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be LEADORE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC.,

ARTICLE II.

SECTION 1. The purposes of this corporation are:

A. To sponsor social and recreational activities which shall be in the best interest of the senior citizens of this area and to do whatever can be done by said corporation for the betterment of the community.

B. To serve primarily persons residing in Leadore, Idaho, by providing or obtaining a place for such persons to assemble and exchange ideas and to enjoy special programs, to entertain and to inform the said senior citizens.

C. To receive monies, equipment or labor or other items from any source, private, city, county, state, federal or whatever, or purchase, convey, mortgage and lease all kinds of real and personal property or otherwise use funds for the accomplishment of the purposes stated herein;

D. To loan money to accept notes, checks, drafts, bonds, debentures, negotiable instruments and other instruments for the payment of money and to receive mortgages or pledges of property to secure such obligations accepted;

E. To borrow money and to draw, make, accept, endorse, assign, guarantee, execute and issue notes, checks, drafts, bonds, debentures, negotiable instruments, for the payment of money and to mortgage or pledge its property to secure such obligations;

F. To have, exercise and enjoy all powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly all the powers and privileges granted to corporations under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and in present and future amendments, thereto, and to engage in any other activity and to do any act or other thing necessary to carry into effect the aforementioned purposes.

G. To exercise and perform all of the above-described powers both within and without the State of Idaho;

SECTION 2. This corporation shall be a non-profit, non-political and non-sectarian organization;

B. This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code;

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code;

D. Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE III.

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND REGISTERED AGENT

The corporation shall have its principal place of business and registered agent located at the Leadore Trailer Court, Apartment #3 in Leadore, County of Lemhi, State of Idaho. The registered agent is Ethel Donlan.

ARTICLE IV.

MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATES

This corporation shall issue membership certificates and the property rights or interests of each member shall be equal, and said corporation hereby provides for the admission of new members who shall be entitled to vote and to share in the property of the corporation with the old members in

accordance with such general rule or rules applicable to all members by which the voting power and the property rights and interest, respectively, of each member are determined and fixed.

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

The members of the governing board of this corporation shall be styled directors. The first Board of Directors shall consist of five (5) persons. The number of directors of this corporation may, from time to time, be increased or decreased, providing that the number of directors shall not be reduced to less than three (3), by an amendment to the by-laws of the corporation to that regard, and without the necessity of amending these articles. The directors are the incorporators.
