#### **TENSED COMMUNITY CHURCH INCORPORATED**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **third** day of **March,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-Nine,** and is duly recorded on Film No. **106** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Tensed,** in the County of **Beneviah,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

Articles of Incorporation of Tensed Sunday School and  
Community Church

Know all men by these present that we, all full-age citizens of the United States.

do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Idaho relating to the creation of a domestic non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the said corporation shall be Tensed Community Church Incorporated and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The object, business or pursuit of this corporation shall be to own, operate, and maintain a church for religious purposes, and to assist in all other ways to advance the cause of the Lord Jesus Christ and to acquire, own, sell, mortgage, and dispose of real estate, buildings, anywhere.

ARTICLE III

The estimated value of the property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of making said article is ten thousand dollars, (\$10,000.00). The source of revenue and income shall be from gifts, donations, bequests, contributions, and income from investments.

ARTICLE IV

The names and post office addresses of the persons executing these articles are as follows;

ARTICLE V

The corporate functions of the corporation shall be exercised by a Board of Directors, five in number and a secretary; reserving however the power to increase that number from time to time. The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by the voting members annually. The annual meeting shall be convened during the fourth week of September each year. The Board of Directors is authorized between the annual meetings to fill any vacancies in its membership because of death, resignation or disability.

ARTICLE VI

The Tensed Community Church shall be a non-denominational church. The Tensed Community Church shall not enter into an alliance to become denominational until such time as there are three denominational churches in Tensed, and only with the written consent of 95% of the eligible voting members. Any agreement entered into

otherwise id void. This article number six shall not be amended or changed in any way.

#### ARTICLE VII

The address of the principal office of said corporation is: Tensed, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE VIII

I certify that a meeting was held to elect directors at Tensed Community Church on the 9<sup>th</sup> of Feb 1959; that a majority of the members present voted at this election: that Henry A. Toland, Wayne Daman, Myron Johnson, Edward Berreth, Stewart Dorkman and Harvey Kammerzell (Secretary) were elected as directors; that notice of such meeting was published in the St. Maries Gazette; St. Maries, Idaho., and posted on the bulletin board of the church two weeks in advance of the time of such meeting.
