Articles of Amendment (Non-Profit)

Article 8:

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section $501_{(C)(3)}$ of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
