### CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

and that the said articles of amendment contain the statement of facts required by law, and are recorded on Film No. **112** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho.

I THEREFORE FURTHER CERTIFY, That the Articles of Incorporation have been amended accordingly.

# CERTIFICATE OF EXTENSION OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

We, Wm. E. Burks and Rose Cobb, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and the Secretary, respectively, of the First Presbyterian Church of Jerome, Idaho, a corporation, do hereby certify as follows:

That the said First Presbyterian Church of Jerome, Idaho, was incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho by Articles of Incorporation dated September 3, 1910, and recorded September 8, 1910, and that the term of corporate existence of said corporation as set forth in its said Articles of Incorporation was for the period of fifty (50) years.

That at a meeting of the members of said corporation, held on the 30th day of October, 1960, it was voted by two-thirds of its members present at such meeting, that the term of the corporate existence of said corporation be made perpetual.

That said vote of said members was upon a resolution regularly introduced and voted upon and carried as aforesaid, which said resolution was and is in words as follows:

"RESOLVED, That the First Presbyterian Church of Jerome, Idaho, a corporation, hereby extends the term of its corporate existence from fifty years, the period set forth in its original Articles of Incorporation, to a perpetual existence."

That the said meeting of the members of said corporation was duly and regularly called by the Board of Trustees expressly for considering the extension of the term of corporate existence of said corporation; that notice of the time and place of holding such meeting was given by publication for at least once a week for three weeks in the North Side News, a newspaper printed and published in Jerome, Idaho, as appears by affidavit of the publisher of said newspaper attached hereto and made a part hereof, and by posting in a conspicuous place in the

building where said meeting was to be held for the same length of time, as appears by affidavit of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of said corporation attached hereto and made a part hereof.

That we, the said Wm. E. Burks and Rose Cobb, acted as and were the presiding officer and secretary, respectively, of said meeting.

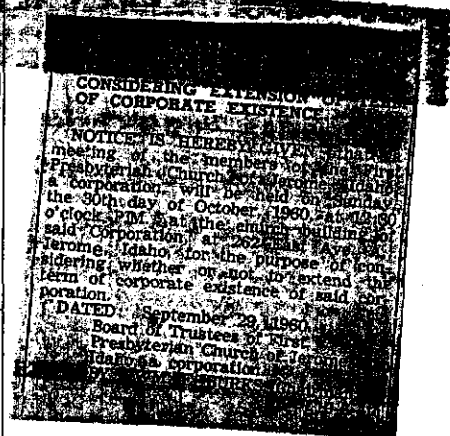
