Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of Secretary of Christian and Missionary Alliance, Incorporation of Secretary of Christian And Missionary of Chr

Note to Secretary of State's office: The year 2000 amendments to the 1942 Articles of Incorporation will read below in *Italics*. Words not italicized indicate that there has been no change in the language from the originally filed 1942 document. Any amendment ending in ... indicates that the remainder of that article shall remain as it was originally stated in the articles of incorporation from 1942. Significant changes are located in articles V and VI. Please contact the church office at 208/743-3000 with any questions.

Article III should now read as follows:

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows: To promote the cause of the Christian religion; to promulgate the doctrines and teachings of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, a corporation organized under the laws of the *State of Colorado*, with which Society this corporation is affiliated and connected as a subordinate body, and should said Society cease to exist as a corporate body in affiliation, cooperation or connection with the said parent Society; viz., The Christian and Missionary Alliance, having its principle office at 8595 Explorer Drive, Colorado Springs, Colorado 80920, and subject to its purposes, usages, doctrines and teachings, then all the real and personal property, appurtenances and effects then owned by this Society shall revert and enure to said the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Colorado Springs, Colorado, or to the incorporated or supervising body of The Christian and Missionary Alliance within whose jurisdiction said corporation is located or with which it is affiliated, as provided by law; to provide for its members a place of worship, to be conducted in accordance with the rules and laws of The Christian and Missionary Alliance of Colorado, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Colorado;...

Article V should now read as follows:

The members of this corporation shall be all persons who now are or may hereafter become members of The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church of Lewiston, Idaho, under the rules and manual of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, a Colorado corporation, as embodied and set forth in 1999 edition of The Manual of the Christian and Missionary Alliance and all subsequent editions as released by the national office of the Christian & Missionary Alliance, and any amendments or additions thereto.

Article VI should now read as follows:

The Trustees of this corporation shall be the Executive Committee of the church. This Executive committee shall have charge of the management of the real property of this corporation and are those individuals registered with the State of Idaho as those with charge of the corporation. The qualifications and terms of office, manner of elections, time, place and manner of called meetings and any other powers and duties of the Executive Committee as well as all other elected positions within The Christian and Missionary Alliance, Inc. shall be as set forth in the church bylaws and The 1999 Manual of the Christian and Missionary Alliance and all subsequent editions as released by the national Society.
