EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2020

*Pursuant to Chapter 22, Part 2, Title 30 of the Idaho Entity Transactions Act and Chapter 30,
Part 8, Title 30 of the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act*

Snake River Council, Inc., an Idaho non-profit corporation ("Snake River") and Ore-Idaho Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America, an Idaho non-profit corporation ("Ore-Ida"), do hereby certify as follows:

1. The constituent corporations in the merger (the "Merger") are Snake River, with its principal place of business at 2988 Falls Avenue E, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301-8423, and Ore-Ida, with its principal place of business at 8901 W. Franklin Road, Boise, Idaho 83709-0638.

2. A Plan of Merger (the "Merger Agreement") has been duly authorized and approved by the members of Snake River in accordance with Chapter 22, Part 2, Title 30 of the Idaho Entity Transactions Act (the "IETA"), in accordance with Chapter 30, Part 8, Title 30 of the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act ("Act"), and by the members of Ore-Ida also in accord with IETA and the Act.

3. Pursuant to the Merger Agreement and pursuant to IETA and the Act, Snake River is being merged with and into Ore-Ida, with Ore-Ida being the surviving corporation in the Merger (the "Surviving Corporation").

4. The address of the Surviving Corporation where copies of process may be sent is 8901 W. Franklin Road, Boise, Idaho 83709-0638.

5. The Merger is effective as of March 1, 2020 ("Effective Date").
