

AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Boise Idaho
May 8, 1940

A meeting of Members duly called for the purpose of withdrawing from the Conference and changing the name. Notice had been given a week in advance. At this meeting the following was read:

Brethern:

In recognition of the existing conditions of the Church. The satisfaction, Accomplishments, achievements of those who are working and who would work if the Church were an Independent Organization.

Whereas-the Church is recorded as an Idaho Corporation for religious purposes and for the Citizens of the City and State.

Whereas -the church is not able financially to keep up the Conference Assessments.

Whereas-the church is not able to keep up the Presiding Elder's Assessments .

Whereas -the church is not able to support a Pastor under the existing conditions.

Whereas- a n Independent Organization would be more satisfactory.

Therefore we feel for the best interest of all concerned, that we as Citizens of Boise go on record as opposed to remaining in the Conference.

Furthur be it resolved-that we as Citizens of Boise, stand as a whole, endorsing, urgently requesting the withdrawal from the Conference.

This resolution was adopted by two-thirds majority of the voting power of all Members.

An amendment changing the name of the Church was adopted by two-thirds majority of the voting power. The change from Bethel, AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH to INDEPENDENT CHURCH, INC.

An amendment altering the By-Laws of Church was adopted by a two-third majority of voting power of all Members.

The said Independent Church is to be used for Religious purposes and for the Citizens of the City and State.

Seven Trustees were elected, and this said board of Trustees were adopted by two-thirds majority of voting power of all Members.
