## AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Boise I daho May 8,1940

A meeting of Members duly called for the purpose of withdrawing from the Conference and changing the name. Notice had been given a week in advance. Atothis meeting the following was read:

## Brethern:

In recognition of the existing conditions of the Church. The satisfaction, Accomplishments, achievements of those who are working and who would work if the Church were an Independent Organization.

Whereas-the Church is recorded as an Idaho Copporation for religious purposes and for the Citizens of the City and S tate.

Whereas -the church is not able finacially to keep up the Conference A ssessments.

Whereas-the church is not a ble to keep up the Presiding Elder's Assessments .

Whereas -the church is not able to support a Pastor under the existing conditions.

Whereas an Independent Organization would be more sat-

isfactory.

Therefore we feel for the best interest of all concerned, that we as Citizens of Boise go on record as opposed to remaining in the Conference.

Furthur be it resolved-that we as Citizens of Boise, stand as a whole, end crsing, urgently requesting the withdrawl from the Conference.

This resolution was adopted by two-thirds majority of the voting power of all Members.

An amendment changing the name of the Church was adopted by two-thirds majority of the voting power. The change from Bethel, AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH to INDEPENDENT CHURCH, INC.

two-third majority of voting power of all Members.

The said Independent Church is to be used for Religious pur-

poses and for the Citizens of the City and State.
