

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FIRST PENTECOSTAL CHURCH OF THE
NAZARENE.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned have, pursuant to a resolution and order of a meeting of the members of the Pentecostal Church of the Nazarene, of Emmett, Idaho, duly called and held at Emmett, Gem County, State of Idaho, on the 16th day of August, A. D. 1918, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby constitute this Certificate in writing which, when filed shall constitute the articles of incorporation of the First Pentecostal Church of the Nazarene, of Emmett, Idaho.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation shall be the "FIRST PENTECOSTAL CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE OF EMMETT, IDAHO".

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are
(1) Preaching and promulgation of the Gospel of full salvation according to the Old and New Testament Scriptures, subject to the provisions of the Manual of the Pentecostal Church of the Nazarene of the United States, and subject to the provisions of the government of said Church, as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Assembly of said Church. (2) To acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise, real property for religious and charitable purposes, for use as church and parsonage sites, to borrow money, and to mortgage or pledge such property for the purpose of securing the payment of money so borrowed, to sell and dispose of the same at any time when it shall not be useful for such religious and charitable purposes and to do and perform all things requisite and necessary to the

acquisition, ownership and control of a church and church site to be used as a place of public worship, and a parsonage and site therefor, to be used as a ministerial residence, together with Cemetery grounds, or other grounds such as may be used exclusively for said purposes.

ARTICLE III.

The place where the principal business of this Corporation shall be transacted, shall be in the City of Emmett, County of Gem, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

This Corporation having been formed exclusively for religious and charitable purposes there is no capital stock thereof.

ARTICLE V.

The term for which this Corporation is to exist is Fifty Years after the filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE VI.

The number of Trustees of this Corporation shall be Five (5) and the names and residences of those who shall act as such Trustees, and until their successors are duly elected and qualified shall be:

ARTICLE VII.

Said election of Trustees was held at Bethel Mission in the City of Emmett, Idaho on the 16th day of August, A. D. 1918, the notice of the time and place of holding such election was duly given as provided by law, by publication in a newspaper of general circulation, printed

and published in said City of Emmett, Idaho, for two consecutive weeks immediately preceding said election, and by posting a like notice for the same length of time in a conspicuous place on said building.

ARTICLE VIII.

The officers of this Corporation shall be President, Secretary and Treasurer, and the President shall be chosen from the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IX.

The Board of Trustees shall have power to make and adopt such By-laws as they may deem prudent not inconsistent with the Laws of the State of Idaho and the Manual and Rules and Regulation of the Pentecostal Church of the Nazarene for the regulation and control of the conduct and business of said Corporation.
