ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
FRONTIER CHRYSLER, PLYMOUTH, DODGE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the undersigned, being a natural person of full age and citizen of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes herein-after stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is FRONTIER CHRYSLER, PLYMOUTH, DODGE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed and the powers of such corporation are as follows:

1. To enter into the business of selling, repairing and leasing new and used automobiles.
2. To own and hold real and personal property and to rent or lease the same.
3. To do any and all things necessary, reasonable, proper, convenient or incident to carrying out the purposes for which this corporation is formed.
4. To borrow money and to pledge, mortgage or hypothecate corporation property, or in any way or manner secure the payment of the same.

5. To conduct business in this state or any other state, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and foreign countries or territories, and to maintain one or more places of business outside of this state, and to receive, purchase, hold, acquire, mortgage, assign, transfer, lease, release, convey and otherwise deal in and with any real or personal property or any interest therein, either within or outside the State of Idaho, reasonably calculated to promote the purposes hereinabove stated to this corporation.

6. To acquire the operating name, good will, property rights, and the whole or any part of any estate, tangible or intangible, or of any business, and to assume the liabilities of any person, firm, association, corporation or other business organization and pay for said good will, property rights, and assets in cash and the stock of this company, its bonds, its debentures, or otherwise, or by undertaking the whole or any part of the liabilities of the transferor thereof, and to hold in any manner or dispose of all or any part of the property so acquired.

7. To conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired and to exercise all of the powers necessary and expedient in and about the conduct and management of such business or businesses, directly or indirectly related to the purposes and objects of this corporation, or, though not so connected, to preserve or protect the assets of this corporation.

8. To purchase, insofar as the same may be done without impairing the capital of this corporation, except as otherwise prohibited by law, and to hold, pledge and reissue shares of its own capital stock, but such stock so acquired and held shall not be entitled to vote nor to receive dividends.

9. To have, exercise, enjoin and participate in all powers, now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, particularly all of the powers and privileges granted to corporations by Chapter I, Title 30, Idaho Code, including any future amendments thereto, and to do any act or thing necessary or convenient for the transaction of the aforesaid business or businesses and for the carrying into effect of any and all objects and purposes of this corporation.

10. To do all things which a natural person might do, it being expressly provided that the aforesaid enumeration of purposes shall not be construed to be limitations upon the powers and purposes of this corporation.

### ARTICLE III

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is 1088 West 6th South, Mountain Home, Idaho 83647, and the registered agent of the corporation at that address is Robert J. Hartung.

ARTICLE V

The capital stock of this corporation shall be the sum of \$260,000.00, divided into 260,000 shares of common stock, each having a par value of \$1.00 per share. No distinction shall exist between the shares of this corporation and all such shares shall have the same rights in such corporation and shall be non-assessable when paid in full.

ARTICLE VI

The name and post office address of the incorporator and organizer, who has named himself as the director to serve until the first election of directors of the corporation, are as follows:

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.
