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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Teton Valley Trails and Pathways Incorporated

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation is **Teton Valley Trails and Pathways, Incorporated.**

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the Corporation are formed are for, educational, and charitable purposes within the meaning of §501(c)(3) and §509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (references in these Articles to particular provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 shall be deemed to include the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated in the public interest and is constituted so as to attract substantial support from governmental organizations and public contributions, whether directly or indirectly, and is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary profit or financial gain; and no part of the assets, income or profit of the Corporation is distributable to, or inure to the benefit of, its Directors or officers or any private individual.

The specific purposes of the Corporation are to provide a County-wide system of public pathways, including pedestrian, bicycle, nordic skiing, and equestrian trails and pathways in Teton County, Idaho and Teton County, Wyoming. To that end, the purposes and activities of the Corporation shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:

- a. Obtaining grants and contributions to fund the acquisition of easements and the construction and maintenance of trails and pathways and associated amenities;

ARTICLE VIII

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Corporation shall, after paying or making provision of the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations described in §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as the Corporation shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by: (a) a
