ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

L. & J. EQUIPMENT CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned citizens of the United States of America, each over the age of twenty-one years, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a domestic corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby make, sign, acknowledge, and file these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is and shall be the L. & J. Equipment Co., Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The object and purposes for which this corporation is formed are as principals, agents or otherwise, to do in any part of the world any and every of the things herein set forth or permitted by law to the same extent as natural persons might and could do. In furtherance and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, we do expressly provide that the corporation shall have power:

- (a) To manufacture, buy, sell, import, export, and to deal generally in new and used or new or used construction and industrial equipment of any and every type or character whatsoever. Also, to act as manufacturers and others' agents in the purchase, sale, handling and distribution of goods, wares, and merchandise of all types and descriptions.
- (b) To purchase, sell, option, own, lease, or otherwise acquire, mortgage and dispose of all lands and real property necessary or incidental to the operation and the conduct of the business of this corporation.

(c) To enter into, make, perform and carry out any and all contracts, or agreement os every kind, amount and character with any person, firm, association, or corporation, Federal or State government or any political subdivision or corporation or agency thereof. To purchase, own, sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, exchange, acquire by operation of law or otherwise, personal property of every kind and character, debts, dues and demands or causes of action, and each and every kind of personal property, evidences of debts, bonds, stocks of this and other corporations, both public and private, which the corporation may deem necessary and convenient for its business or otherwise. (e) To borrow and lend money from and to any person, firm, corporation, association, or Federal or State government or any political subdivision, or corporation or agency thereof, and to make, take and execute notes, mortgages, bonds, deeds of trust, or other evidences of indebtedness to secure payment thereof, or by any other lawful manner or means, and to take and receive notes, bonds, mortgages, deeds of trust, or any evidence of in-

debtedness for the use and benefit of said corporation, or otherwise.

(f) To do and perform every act and thing necessary to carry out the above-enumerated purposes, or calculated directly or indirectly to the advancement of the interest of the corporation or to the enhancement of the value of its stock, holdings, and

property of any kind or character.

The corporate existance of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

That the place where the principal business of this cor-

poration shall be transacted and the location and post office address of the corporation's registered office in this State shall be 4835 Chinden Blvd., Boise, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The authorized capital stock of this corporation shall \$25,000.00 divided into be/1,000 shares of common stock of a par value of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per share. All stock shall be fully paid and non-assessable, and shall be subject to pre-emptive rights not-withstanding the provisions of Section 30-120, Paragraph 6B of the Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE VI.

That the corporate powers of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors which shall consist of at least three and not more than nine directors, as may be determined from time to time by the By-laws.
