



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL RAILROAD COMPANY.

THESE PRESENTS WITNESS: That we, FRED C. RUMMEL, president and J. BERNHEIM, secretary, in conformity with the uniform Business Corporation Act of the State of Washington, do make and sigh the following articles of amendment in triplicate:

ARTICLE I.

At a meeting of the shareholders duly called upon ten days' notice of the specific purpose, and held on the 8th day of January, 1953, the following resolution providing an amendment to the articles of incorporation was proposed:

RESOLVED that ARTICLE V of the Articles of Incorporation be amended so as to read as follows:

"The total authorized number of shares of stock of the Corporation shall be Three Hundred Thousand (300,000), all of which shall be Common Stock and without par value."

ARTICLE II.

The aforesaid resolution, proposing an amendment to the articles of incorporation, was adopted by the affirmative vote of the holders of two-thirds of the voting power of all shareholders of the corporation.

ARTICLE III.

The total number of shares, which the corporation is authorized to issue is 50,000; the total number of shares which the corporation will thenceforth be authorized to have is 300,000.

All of the authorized shares are shares without parvalue.

Such shares may be issued by the corporation from time to time for such consideration as may be fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors thereof, subject to the approval of the Interstate Commerce Commission.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have this 2 day of March, 1953, executed these articles of amendment in triplicate on behalf of the above named corporation and under the corporate seal.
