ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SNO DRIFTERS LATAH COUNTY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being all of legal age, and citizens of the United States of America, have voluntarily associated ourselves and do upon the date of these presents, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation of social, educational, benevolent and charitable character under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be SNO DRIFTERS LATAH COUNTY, INC.".

ARTICLE II.

The location and post office address of the registered office in the State of Idaho shall be Moscow, Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The duration and term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, this corporation shall have the following objects, purposes and powers:

To stimulate and advance the general welfare and safety of snowmobiling and to promote a medium for the exchange of snowmobiling information; to promote the use and care of snowmobiling as an enjoyable and beneficial type of recreation; to promote interest in and further the training of persons in the proper care, safety and handling of snowmobiles; to encourage good sportsmanship

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mobiling as to recreation, competition and otherwise; to participate in and sponsor competition, contests, races, cross country trail rides and other forms of similar enjoyment and fun in respect to snowmobiling with members of this organization as well as non-members and members of other and similar organizations; to do such things independently or in conjunction with non-members as well as with members of other and similar organizations; to participate independently or in conjunction with others in search and rescue endeavors and activities; to promote and encourage better understanding among the members and the general public as to the proper use of snowmobiles and related equipment; and to promote, encourage and educate the members and the general public in the principals of safety in the use of snowmobiles and related equipment.

To acquire, own, hire, lease and provide facilities consisting of both real and personal property, equipment, and gear for its members and in furtherance of its objects and purposes.

To do all things in connection with its objects permitted by law and to exercise any and all powers not prohibited by law as pertains to organizations of this type.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation is not organized for profit and shall have no capital stock, and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders in accordance with the foregoing provisions.

ARTICLE VI.

The conditions and regulations of membership and the rights and privileges of members shall be determined and fixed by the By-laws.

ARTICLE VII.

The private property of the members shall not be subject to the payment of the corporate debts, liabilities or obligations to any extent whatsoever.

ARTICLE VIII.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than three nor more than one hundred as set from time to time in the By-Laws of the corporation. The Directors' qualifications and terms of office, manner of election (except the first Board of Directors which was elected as herein set forth), time, place, and manner of calling meetings and other powers and duties of the Directors shall be prescribed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IX.

The officers of this Corporation shall consist of a President, a VicePresident, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be provided
by the By-Laws, and their qualifications, terms of office, manner of election,
time, place and manner of calling meetings and other powers and duties shall
be prescribed by the By-Laws. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be
combined into one and held by one person.
