

Certificate of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned, being the President and the Secretary of MD4 Clinical Research, Inc., certify that an appropriate majority of the holders of such shares of the Corporation entitled to vote have authorized the following Amendment(s) to the Articles of Incorporation of MD4 Clinical Research, Inc., at a shareholder meeting of September 18, 1997. CAPITALIZATION
