Purpose of Corporation

Section 1. The purpose of the Lapwai Valley Quick Response Unit, Inc. will be as follows:

A. To provide emergency care for ill and injured persons, and to perform rescue-extrication on land and water when necessary, within the limitations of the knowledge and skills afforded members by the Quick Response Unit training course and within the geographic limits for response as defined by the Chief of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) until an exchange can be made to an ambulance which will transport the patient to a hospital.

B. To continue to upgrade the knowledge and skills of members for emergency care of ill and injured persons through periodic training sessions, of which there will be no less than one every two months.

C. Lapwai Valley Quick Response Unit will promote community understanding of preventing accidents and teach first aid techniques.

D. Lapwai Valley Quick Response Unit will render assistance in any local, county, state or national emergency including Civil Defense work as necessary or directed by Emergency Medical Services.
