PREAMBLE

**SECRETARY OF STATE**

These Articles of Incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation known as a church under the provisions of Title 30, Idaho Code, as follows.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be as follows:  
Saint Basil's Orthodox Catholic ~~Church~~, Incorporated.  
~~Congregation~~

ARTICLE II

The purposes of this corporation with regard to its incorporation are as follows:

1. To foster and perpetuate, by any and all proper and legitimate means the dissemination and inculcation of the Christian faith in the Orthodox tradition;
2. To construct buildings to be used for liturgical purposes or other ecclesiastical functions;
3. To undertake missionary responsibilities;
4. To procure and hold copyrights;
5. To print, publish, buy, sell and otherwise circulate literature in any language and country;
6. To receive gifts, legacies and donations, from any legitimate sources or source;
7. To make gifts and appropriations from all of its sources, from time to time when deemed appropriate in consonance with the objects or purposes of the congregation;
8. To otherwise do all things necessary and proper for the accomplishment of its purposes ends.

Further, it is declared that regardless of purpose or legitimate activity, this corporation contemplates only that operational posture which allows for benevolent, religious and charitable functioning, with no intent for gain or individual profit and that no dividends shall ever be declared or paid to any of its members, and that none of its property, real or personal, shall ever be used or expended except in carrying into effect the legitimate ends and aims of its being.

ARTICLE III

The location of the corporation is in the City of Mountain Home, County of Elmore, State of Idaho. More specifically, the registered agent is Mary A. Wiskirchen and her address is 1560 Sunset Strip, #10, Mountain Home, Idaho 83647.

ARTICLE IV

Said corporation is organized on a non-stock basis. Said corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: By contributions, pledges of funds, and property absolutely or in trust for its purposes as herein stated and for no other purpose.

## ARTICLE VI

The number of officers of the corporation shall be as follows:

1. President of the Congregation
2. Vice-President of the Congregation
3. Secretary of the Congregation
4. Treasurer of the Congregation
5. Historian of the Congregation

## ARTICLE VII

This corporation being benevolent, religious and charitable, its term is unlimited and in perpetuity.

## ARTICLE VIII

The number of members to this corporation shall be unlimited.

## ARTICLE IX

All of the property of this corporation and accumulation thereof shall be held and administered to effect its purposes and to serve for the general welfare of its membership.

## ARTICLE X

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal, upon the reaching of a two-thirds majority vote of the members present at the time the vote is taken, all of the provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon the members and officers herein are granted subject to this reservation.
