ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SPOKANE AND EASTERN RAILWAY AND POWER COMPANY

We, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter specified, and in conformity to the laws of the State of Washington, do make and subscribe the following written Articles of Incorporation in triplicate:

1. The name of this corporation shall be

SPOKANE AND EASTERN RAILWAY AND POWER COMPANY.

2. The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are and shall be to construct and operate steam and electric railroads and railways connecting the City of Spokane with adjacent cities, towns, villages and communities in the states of Washington and Idaho; to purchase, acquire, construct, operate and sell such railroads and railways into and out of the City of Spokane, and to acquire, construct and maintain or to lease terminal grounds and facilities therefor; to buy, lease or otherwise acquire other railways and rights of way therefor and to operate the same when so acquired as a part of its said system or systems; to construct, operate or otherwise acquire railways and rights of way therefor other than railways into and out of the City of Spokane anywhere in the states of Washington, Idaho and Oregon, or elsewhere in any state of the United States, and to operate the same when so acquired and constructed as a part of its said system or systems; to acquire and to construct or operate systems of street railways in the City of Spokane, Washington, and in other cities, towns and villages of the states of Washington and Idaho, or any other state of the United States; to acquire or construct and to operate electric light plants in

1 the City of Spokane and in other cities, towns and villages of  
2 said states; to construct and operate electric light systems  
3 in the states of Washington and Idaho and in other states of the  
4 United States, outside of cities, towns and villages, for the  
5 accomodation of farming and suburban communities; to purchase,  
6 acquire by condemnation or otherwise, to improve and develop  
7 and to generate and sell power for electrical, manufacturing  
8 and other power purposes; to purchase, acquire by condemnation  
9 or otherwise, and to improve, develop, generate, transmit and  
10 distribute electricity for its own purposes for power and light-  
11 ing, and to sell the same for power, heat and light purposes to  
12 cities, towns and villages in the said states and others; to  
13 construct in the City of Spokane and in other cities, towns and  
14 villages in the said states, and in the farming communities of  
15 said states, poles, wires and the necessary appliances for  
16 transmitting and distributing electricity for any of the pur-  
17 poses for which it may lawfully transmit and use the same under  
18 these Articles of Incorporation.

19 To apply for and receive from the said City of Spokane  
20 and other cities, towns and villages in said states franchises  
21 to use the streets and to occupy the same and to cross the same  
22 so far as may be necessary, proper and convenient for the pur-  
23 poses authorized by these Articles, both for the operation of  
24 railways and street railways and for the accomodation of its  
25 poles and wires and for the transmission and distribution of  
26 electric power or any of the purposes for which electric power  
27 may be used or transmitted under these Articles; and to receive  
28 from the said City of Spokane and other cities, towns and villages  
29 in the said states franchises to occupy the streets thereof with  
30 poles, wires and other necessary apparatus for furnishing elec-  
tric light and power for municipal railway or other purposes; to

1 apply for and receive from the counties of said states, or from  
2 such other body or bodies as have authority in the premises,  
3 franchises to occupy the roads and highways with its tracks and  
4 with its poles and wires, and to operate its system of railway  
5 and its system of electric transmission thereon; to purchase,  
6 lease or otherwise acquire realty in any of the said states and  
7 to build on or otherwise improve said realty and to sell, lease  
8 or otherwise dispose of the same; to sell, lease or otherwise  
9 dispose of any of the systems of railroads, railways, street  
10 railways, electric light plants, power plants, electric light  
11 systems or other property which it has the right to acquire or  
12 operate under these Articles of Incorporation.

13 To borrow money for its corporate purposes and to execute  
14 its notes, bonds or other obligations as evidence of such in-  
15 debtedness, and to secure said notes, bonds or other obligations  
16 by liens, encumbrances, mortgages or deeds of trust upon all or  
17 any part of its property, and to negotiate and sell such notes,  
18 bonds or other evidences of indebtedness.

19 To purchase, acquire, own, vote, sell or otherwise manage  
20 or dispose of the stock in whole or in part of any corporation  
21 organized under the laws of the State of Washington, or under  
22 the laws of the United States or any state of the United States.

23 To purchase, acquire, operate, lease, sell or otherwise  
24 dispose of all or any part of the franchises, railways, plants,  
25 systems and other property formerly operated by the Spokane and  
26 Inland Empire Railroad Company; to do any and all things proper,  
27 necessary or convenient to carry out any of the foregoing pur-  
28 poses.

30 3. The amount of the capital stock of this corporation  
shall be Three Million (\$3,000,000.) Dollars, divided into

thirty thousand (30,000) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars per share.

4. The time of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years from and after the third day of January, A.D. 1920.

5. The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be nine (9), and the names and residences of the Trustees who shall manage the concerns of the corporation until the third day of July, 1920, are as follows:

6. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be located in the City of Spokane, County of Spokane, State of Washington.
