

## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MILLENIAL TECHNOLOGY, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of <u>Idaho Code</u>, § 30-1-1006 of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and the provisions of Article V, Section 3, of the corporation's original Articles of Incorporation, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is MILLENNIAL TECHNOLOGY, INC.

**SECOND**: The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the incorporator - director of the corporation on August 15, 2000, in the manner prescribed by the Idaho Business Corporation Act:

- 1. ARTICLE I, <u>Name</u>: The name of the corporation is **MILLEN<u>N</u>IAL TECHNOLOGY**, **INC**.
- 2. ARTICLE III, Section 1. <u>PURPOSES</u>: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to <u>study</u>, <u>research</u>, <u>develop</u>, and <u>market applications of radiation science</u>, <u>low-energy charged-particle accelerators</u>, and <u>related technology</u>; to carry on all other business incident thereto or connected therewith and to engage in any other lawful activities.
- 3. ARTICLE VI, <u>REGISTERED OFFICE</u>: The physical address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2104 South 100 East, Oakley, Cassia County, Idaho, 83346. <u>The mailing address is c/o Brady Lerma, Chartered, P.O. Box 1398, Boise, Idaho 83701-1398</u>. The registered agent at the physical address is Bruce Mitchell.

**THIRD**: The total number of issued shares of common stock in the corporation is 1,000,000 shares, with one share of common stock of the corporation outstanding and entitled to vote at the time of such adoption.
