The undersigned, being duly licensed and qualified to practice medicine in the State of Idaho, in order to form a professional corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Idaho Professional Service Corporation Act and the Idaho Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation.

ARTICLE I

No director of the Corporation shall be personally liable to the Corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director except:

- b. For facts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law.
- Liability under Idaho Code §30-1-48. C.
- d. For any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit.
