WE, the undersigned persons, residents of the State of Idaho and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE ONE

Name

The name of the corporation shall be THE SALMON RIVER BOARD OF REALTORS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

ARTICLE THREE

Duration

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

Purpose

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are the following:

A. To unite those engaged in the recognized branches of the real estate profession in this community for the purpose of exerting a beneficial influence upon the profession and related interests.

B. To promote and maintain high standards of conduct in the real estate profession as expressed in the Code of Ethics of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS.

C. To provide a unified medium for real estate owners and those engaged in the real estate profession whereby their interests may be safeguarded and advanced.

D. To further the interest of home and other real property ownership.

E. To unite those engaged in the real estate profession in this community with the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS, thereby furthering their own objectives throughout the state and nation, and obtaining the benefits and privileges of membership therein.

F. To designate, for the benefit of the public, those individuals within its jurisdiction authorized to use the REALTOR AND REALTORS as licensed, prescribed and controlled by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS.
