ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

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RACING HORSEMEN'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a non-profit corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for this non-profit corporation:

I.

The name of this non-profit corporation shall be Racing Horsemen's Association, Inc.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this non-profit corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The address of the initial registered office of this non-profit corporation is 2421 Schiller Road, Emmett, Idaho 83617, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Earl A. Lilley.

IV.

The nature of the business and the object and purpose of this non-profit corporation shall be as follows:

(a) To institute or aid in any movement that will aid or protect the general welfare of the racing industry, the interests of horsemen and their employees, and of backstretch personnel.

- (b) To bring about a closer and more understanding relationship between horsemen, racing associations, racing commissions, and the public.
- (c) To take part and advise with racing associations, racing commissions, and other racing organizations in the establishment of proper rules and conditions which affect in any manner the interests of horsemen, their employees, and backstretch personnel.
- (d) To represent all horsemen's interests and property rights in dealing with racing associations including, but not limited to:
 - (1) purse monies;
 - (2) interest on owner's deposits in horsemen's bookkeeper accounts;
 - (3) the negotiation of purse contracts,
 - (4) the improvement of facilities, and all other matters of interest and benefit to horsemen.

V.

The members of this non-profit corporation shall be any owner or trainer currently licensed by the Idaho State Horse Racing Commission who shall start a horse at Les Bois Park in a race under the Supervisor of the Idaho State Horse Racing Commission and has paid the annual dues as set forth in the By-laws.

VI.

VII.

The first Board of Directors shall consist of eleven (11) directors, but during their term of office, or thereafter, the number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as may be provided by the By-Laws; provided, however, that the number of directors constituting a Board shall not be less than nine (9) nor more than sixteen (16).

VIII.

All or any meetings of the members, or of the Board of Directors, may be held within or without the State of Idaho.

IX.

The members of this non-profit corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of this non-profit corporation.

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No part of the net earnings of this non-profit corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation,

and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

XI.

Upon the dissolution of this non-profit corporation, assets shall not be distributed to officers, directors, members, or other private parties, but only and exclusively for the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof or to an organization established for such purposes.
