ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE PLEASANT VALLEY IRRIGATION CO., LIMITED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, citizens of the State of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and organizing a private corporation under the laws of the state of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

FIRST.

That the name of this corporation is and shall be THE PLEASANT VALLEY IRRIGATION COMPANY, LIMITED, of Boise, Idaho.

SECOND.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are: To take over from the Boise Water and Land Company, Limited, their reservoir site, ditches, laterals and water right, and the entire water system, situated on and near the Ten Mile Creek in Ada County Idaho; and to care for that certain reservoir now constructed and in use in Ada County, Idaho; and to enlarge and maintain the dam, reservoir, laterals and ditches necessary to water and irrigate the lands holding water rights under said water system and to economically and properly distribute the water for irrigation and domestic purposes among the various water users and holders of stock and water deeds that were issued by the said Boise Water and Land Company, Limited, of Boise, Idaho, and to own the title to real estate necessary for the use and enjoyment of said company in connection with the reservoir site and ditches and laterals for the purpose of maintaining and operating said reservoir, ditches and laterals and water system; to borrow money in any amount not to exceed \$25,000 and to pledge and bond the water system for

securing the payment of said bonds, ^{Provided} two-thirds (2/3) of the shareholders' vote in support of said measure ~~provided~~.

THIRD.

- That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is in the City of Boise, County of Ada and State of Idaho, or at such place as the Directors may designate.

FOURTH.

That the time for which this corporation is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of the certificate of its incorporation.

FIFTH.

That the number of its directors is and shall be ^{Five} ~~three~~, and that the names and residences of those appointed for the first year are:

SIXTH.

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation is One Hundred twenty-six thousand, Two Hundred and sixty-four (\$126,264.00) Dollars, divided into 2525.28 shares of the par value of Fifty (\$50) Dollars per share.

SEVENTH.

That the amount of the capital stock which has been actually subscribed is Nine hundred and sixty (960) shares and of the value of \$48,000.00 and the following are the names and residences of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed:

That this corporation shall not be operated for profit but only for the purpose of owning the title to the necessary land appurtenant to said water and irrigation system and for maintaining the same and distributing the water to each of the water users in the manner in which they are entitled under their deeds, conveying to them their water rights:

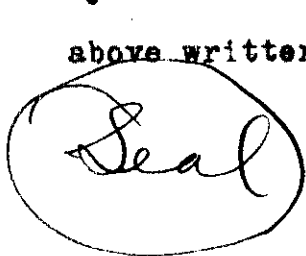
