ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

LEWISTON SOCIETY OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC., A RELIGIOUS CORPORATION.

* *

We, the undersigned, being all citizens of the United States and residents of Lewiston in Nez Perce County in said state, and being all members of the Lewiston Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 29 of Idaho Code Annotated 1932 and acts supplemental thereto and amendatory thereof, and we do hereby certify:

That at a meeting of the members of seid society held in the Methodist Episcopal Church located at the corner of Eighth Street and Sixth Avenue in the City of Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M., on the 27th day of April, 1938, for the purpose of forming a religious corporation of the members of said society under the name of the Lewiston Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, a religious corporation, providing that said corporation shall have perpetual succession, adopting by-laws for said corporation and electing nine (9) trustees thereof, and for the purpose of transacting any and all other business that the members present deemed it expedient to transact in connection with the incorporation of said society, prior to which meeting and election notice of the time and place thereof was given in the manner and form required by law, by publication for at least two (2) weeks in the Lewiston Tribune, a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, a copy of which notice as printed and published is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A" and by reference made a part hereof, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such meeting and election was held for the same length of time, at which

meeting there were Fifty-two (52) members of said society present, the undersigned were elected trustees of said society to hold office until the election and qualification of their successors at the first annual meeting of said society thereafter, and were authorized to adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

ARTICLE II.

The term of existence of this corporation is unlimited and it shall have perpetual succession and existence from and after the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE III. (Purposes)

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows: To establish and maintain a church in the City of Lewiston, in Nez Perce County, State of Idsho, and in connection therewith, a suitable and customary organization for the purpose of public worship and religious training according to the rules and discipline of the Methodist Episcopal Church, under the supervision of the Pacific Northwest Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, which said church shall be subject to the privileges of the government of the Methodist Episcopal Church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said church; to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage and otherwise encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever; to receive, hold and enjoy gifts, devises and legacies; to borrow money, to execute and issue notes and bonds evidencing its indebtedness, and to secure indebtedness by pleage, mortgage or other encumbrance of its property; to rent and lease real property; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise

all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, without in any particular limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such acts, things and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary thereto or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or the members thereof, or enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation, may lawfully do; and in carrying on its objectives and purposes, or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law.

ARTICLE IV. (Principal Office)

The place where the principal office of this corporation shall be maintained and its principal place of business is at Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, and the postoffice and register address of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V. (Membership)

The members of this corporation shall be all persons who now are or may hereafter become members of the Lewiston Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church under the rules and discipline of the Methodist Episcopal Church as embodied and set forth in the Rules and Discipline of the Methodist Episcopal Church published by the authority of the General Conference thereof in the year 1936, and any amendments or additions thereto.

ARTICLE VI. (Trustees)

The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be nine(9). Such trustees shall have charge of the management of the real property of this corporation and the promotion, operation and management thereof, and shall have charge of and the management of all church property for the use of the members of this corporation and the properly constituted church authorities.

The qualifications and terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings and any other powers and duties of the trustees shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

That the following persons were elected on April 27, 1938, to serve as trustees until the 1st annual meeting of the members of this corporation thereafter and until their successors are elected and qualified:

Ralph V. Willett, W. H. Shipley, W.J. Weaver, Harry F. Isaman, J.M. Lyle, Harry W. Christy, Wilbur E. Woods, Marcus J. Ware and F. L. Smith.
